

The 10 Commandments

(Deut.5, 6, Lev.19, Mat.24:36-40)

I am Jehovah your God who brought you out of the land of Egypt, from the house of bondage.

1- There will not be to you any other gods besides Me.

2- You shall not make any image for you; any likeness of anything in the heavens above, or in the earth beneath, and in the waters from under the earth that you should worship them. You shall not bow yourself to them nor serve them.

3- You shall not take the name of Jehovah your God in vain; for Jehovah will not hold him guiltless who takes His name in vain.

4- Keep the Sabbath day, to keep it holy; Six days you shall labor, and shall do all your work, and the seventh day shall be a Sabbath to Jehovah your God.

You shall not do any work, not you and not your son, and not your daughter, nor any that do service to you or they that are yours, nor any stranger within your gates; so that all may rest like yourself.

Remember... You were a slave in the land of Egypt, and Jehovah your God brought you out from there by a mighty hand and by a stretched out arm.

On account of this Jehovah your God has commanded you to keep the Sabbath day.

5- Honor your father and your mother; so that your days may be prolonged, and so that it may be well with you.

6- You shall not commit murder.

7- You shall not commit adultery.

8- You shall not steal.

9- You shall not bear false witness against your neighbor.

10- You shall not covet your neighbor's wife, and not shall you desire your neighbor's house, or anything which is your neighbor's.

Jehovah spoke these words to all the assembly on the Mount, out of the midst of the fire of the cloud and out of the thick darkness with a great voice. And He added no more; writing them on two tablets of stone, and gave them to Moses.

The Two Great Commandments; and these shall be on your heart.

You shall love the Lord your God with all your heart, and with all your soul, and with your entire mind and you shall love your neighbor as yourself. On these two commandments all the Law and the Prophets hang
